

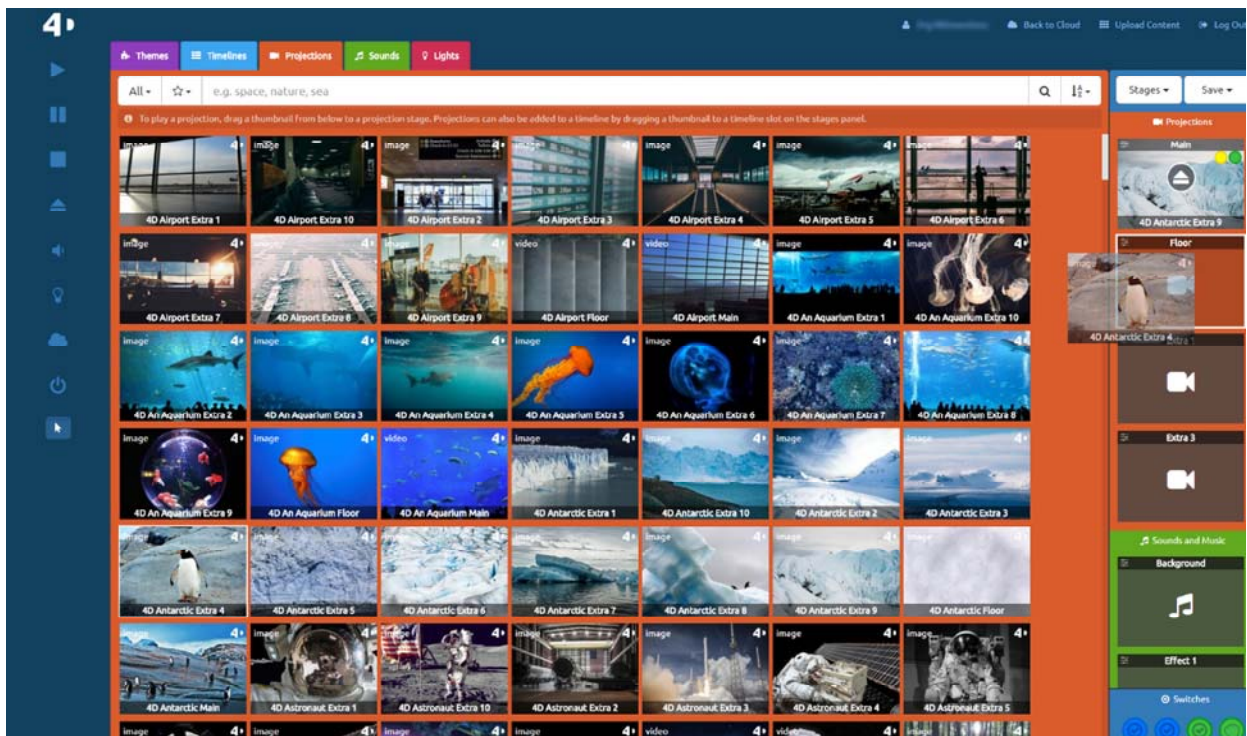
Creating and Editing a Theme

These steps apply when making a theme while **inside** or **outside** the room. You can make a theme through the room controller or access the offline content manager by clicking: **Content** ⇒ **Content Management** menu once you are logged into the cloud.

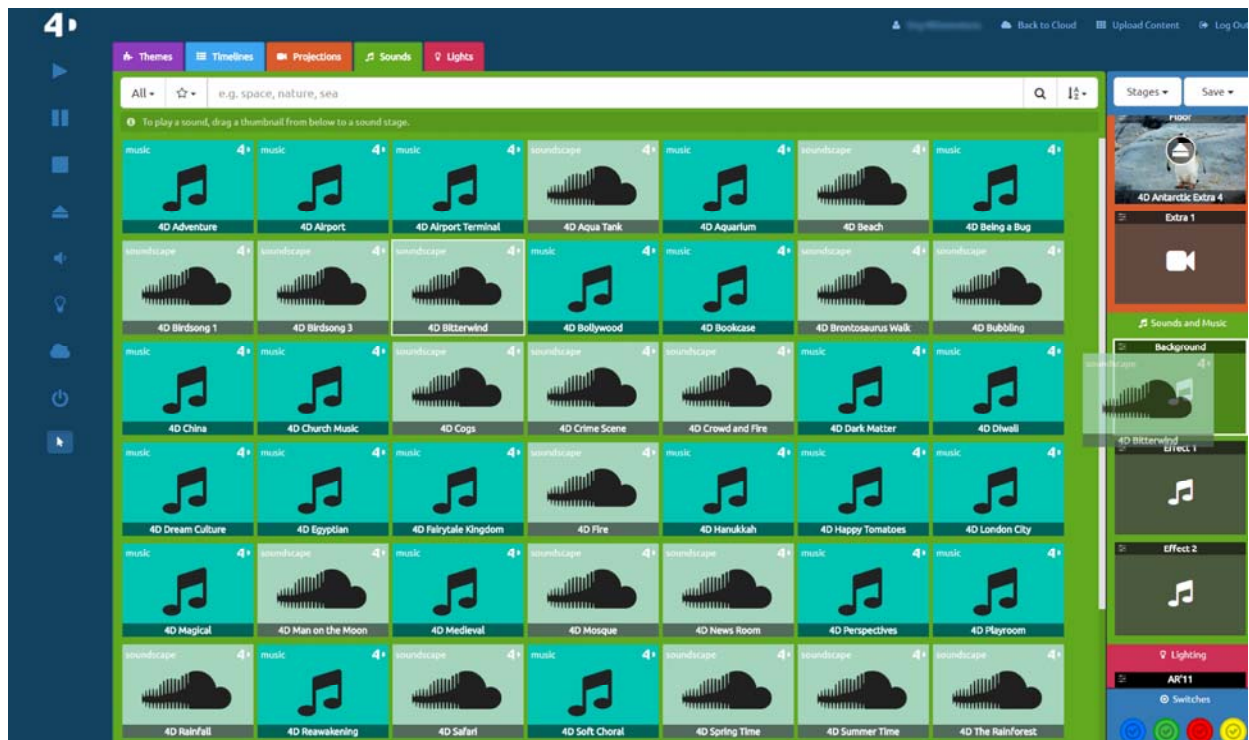
Step 1: Drag content to stages

To create a theme, you need content on your stages. In this example, we will create a theme with two projections, one sound, and one light.

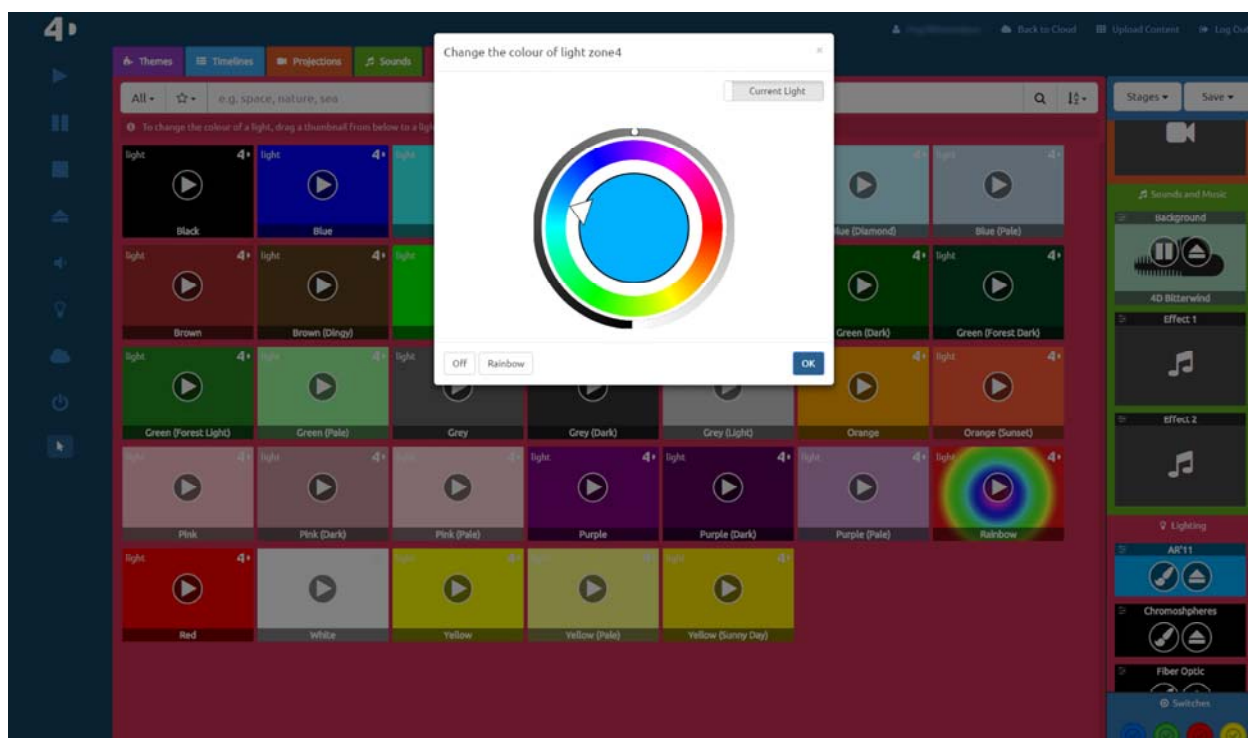
Firstly, go to the projections tab and drag to place projections of your choice on the stages. Here we use 4D Antarctic Extra 9, and 4D Antarctic Extra 4 on the **Main stage**, and **Floor stage**.



Secondly, go to the sounds tab and drag to place a sound of your choice on the sound stages. Here we use 4D Bitterwind on the **Background stage**.

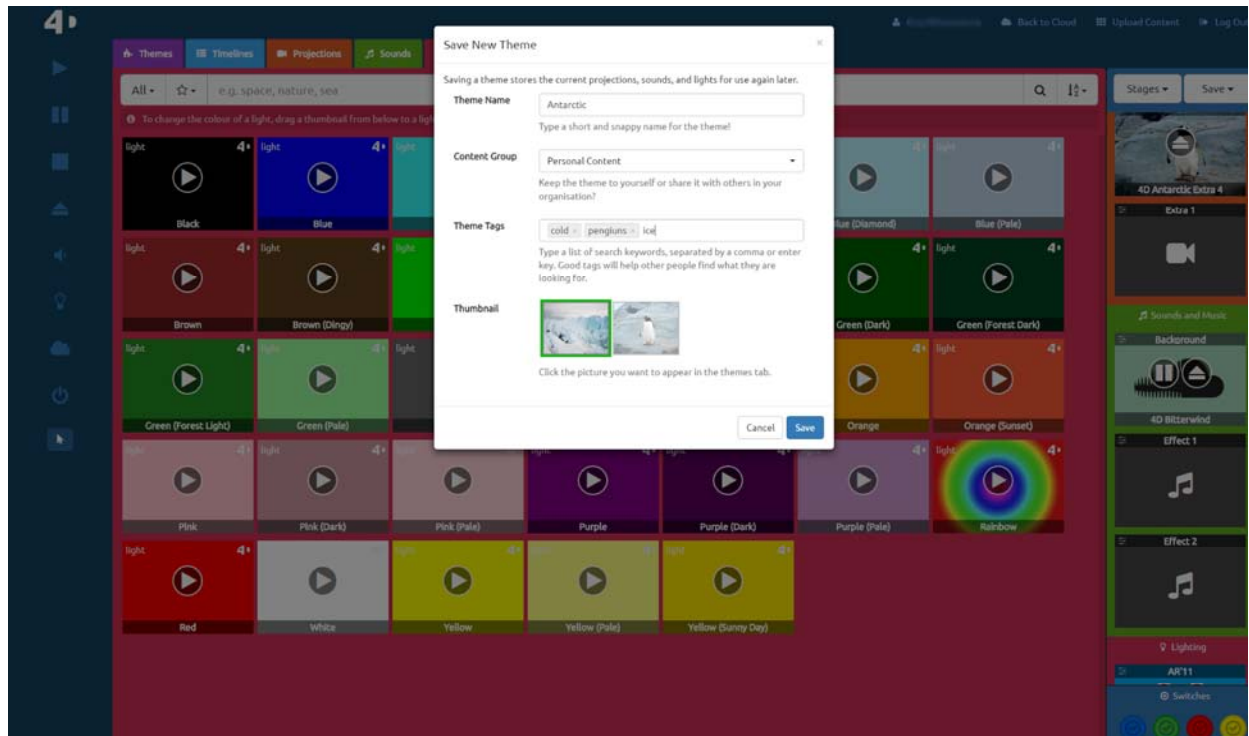


Thirdly, set a light by scrolling down to the light stage on the stages panel on the right. Next, click the paintbrush icon to bring up the colourwheel, and set it to a light blue.

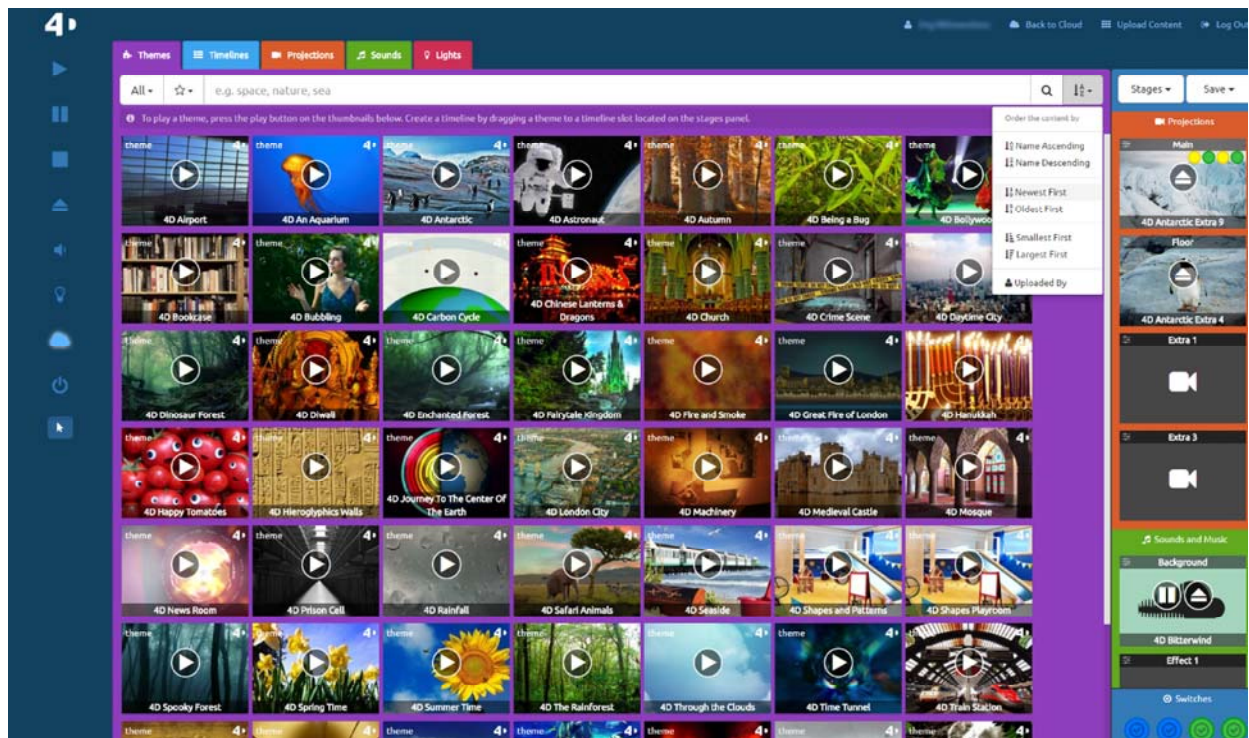


Step 2: Save your theme

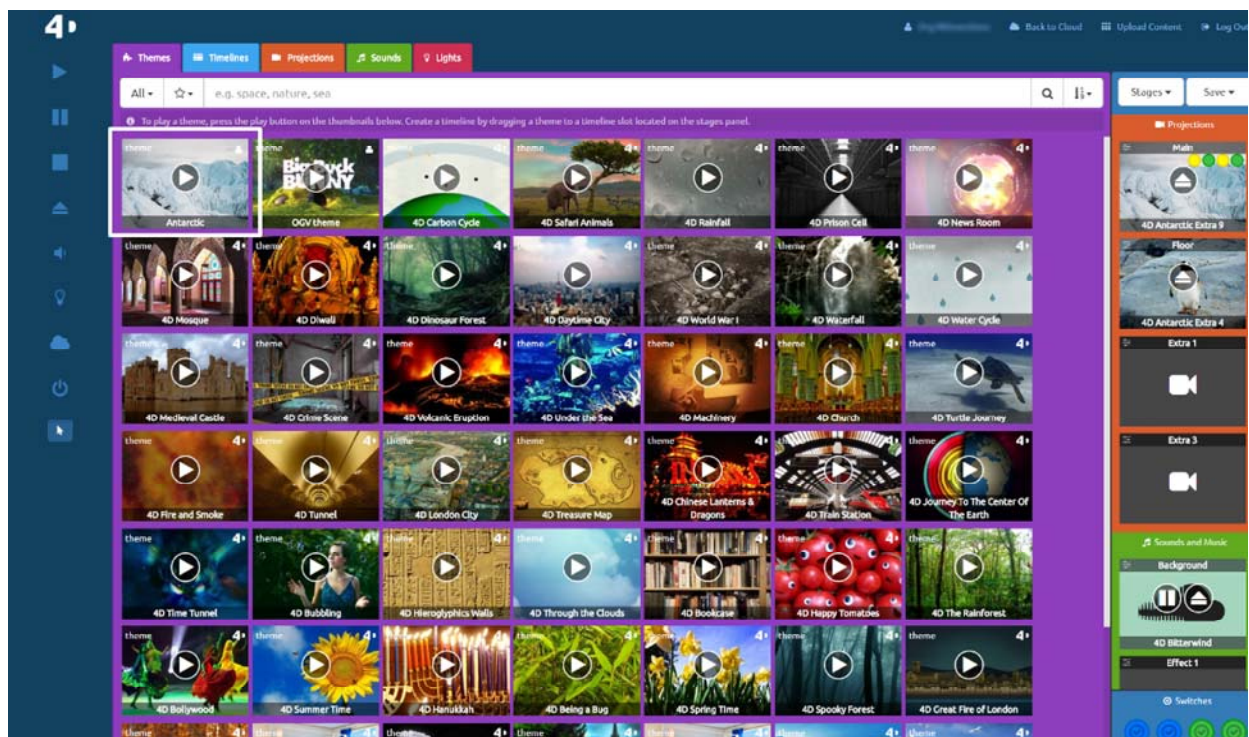
Now you are ready to save your theme. Click on the **Save** dropdown menu on the top of the stages panel on the right, and press **Save As Theme**. You will then be able to set your save options (see below) like setting a theme name, save location, tags, and the thumbnail (which will be shown under the Themes tab).



Once you are ready, press **Save**. You can then find your newly saved under the **Themes** tab. To view your theme at the top (to save having to scroll down and find your newly saved theme) press the button to the right of the search button which looks like a magnifying glass to order the thumbnails. Select the **Newest First** option.

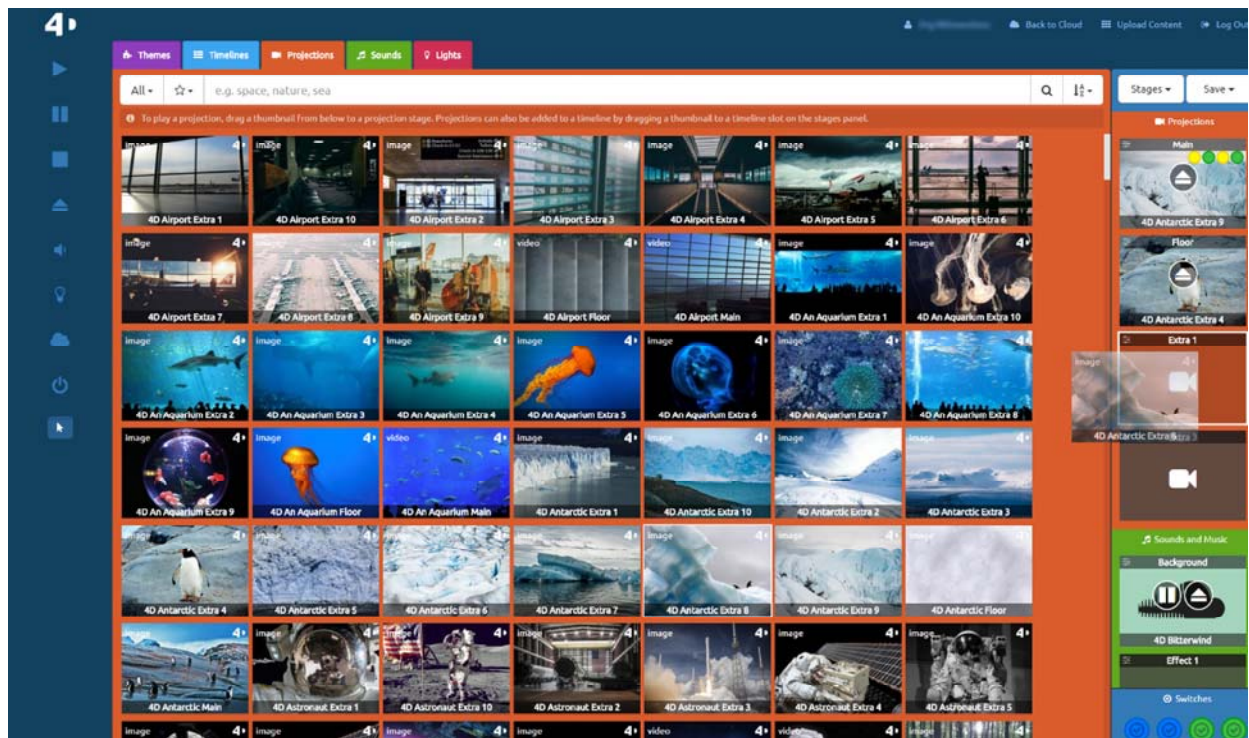


Now your newly created theme is at the top left!

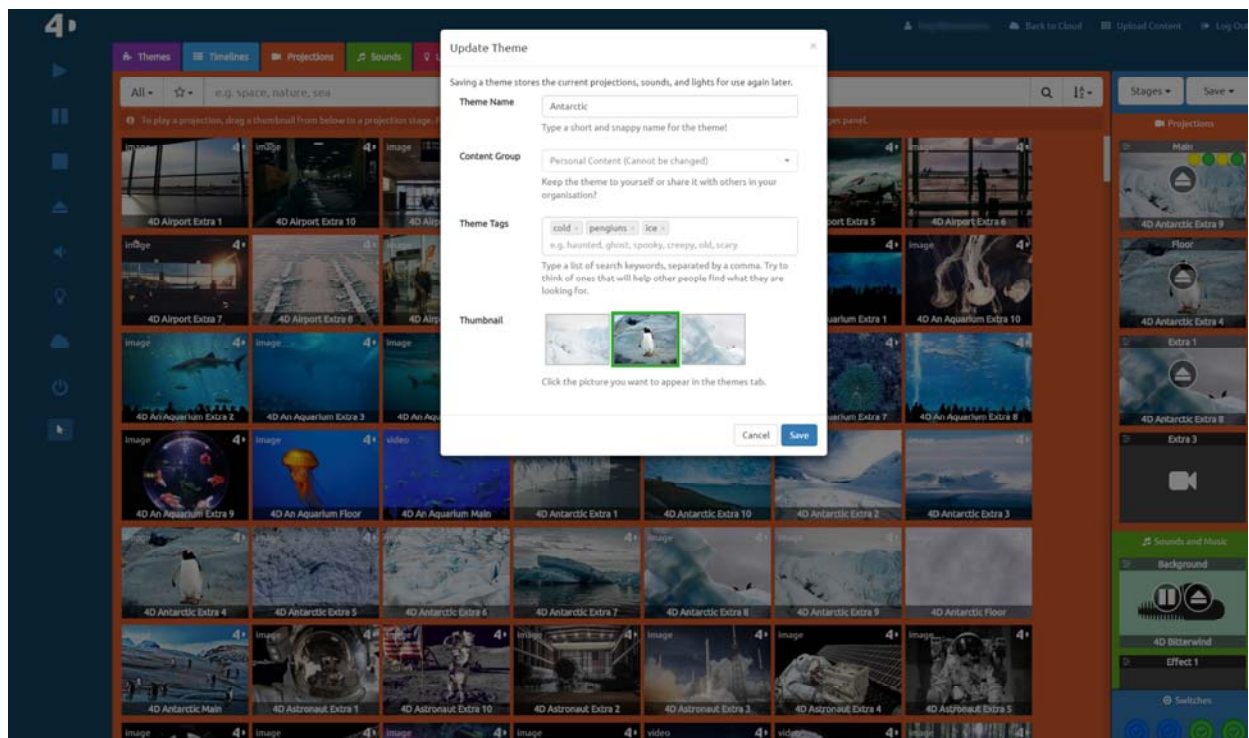


Step 3: Edit your theme

Let's say you want an extra projection into the theme. To do this, first load the theme, by going to the **Themes** tab and press the play button on the theme. Next, drag the another Antarctic related image to the empty projection stage.



Once you placed your new projection, press the **Save** button at the top of the stages panel on the right, then press **Update Theme**. You will then be shown the same menu as when you save a theme. Here you can change the thumbnail, or modify the title, etc. In the example below, a new thumbnail is selected. Once you are ready, press **Save**.



In the themes tab, you can then view your updated theme with the new thumbnail (see below).
